

JUST THE TIPS

WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about the C7 model I don't have one but while researching I found a few things you may want to know about.

The first thing I looked for was known problems, the thing that came up several times is the serpentine belt tensioner. They wear out because they are designed like a small shock absorber and not spring loaded like most tensioners. When they start to wear out they leak the fluid and have to be replaced.

Another thing that came up was the AFM system. Active Fuel Management that shifts the engine in and out of four cylinders for better fuel mileage. As they age they are showing problems across many GM products that it's installed on. The lifters they use with this system are known to fail and oil consumption is a known problem. There are also problems showing up with the transmission because of this system, and there is a class action lawsuit regarding problems with this system.

There is a way to shut this off. You can buy a module that plugs into your OBD2 port and can be removed at anytime. The one most recommended is made by Range technology and are readily available. <u>https://</u> www.rangetechnology.com/products/afm-dfm_disabler/

JUST THE TIPS

WITH RICK LYONS

While I still have some space left I want to mention some products I came across.

• The first is called door dogs. They are door handle extenders to make access easier and make it so you don't have as many hand prints.

• Next is called seat belt stay. I guess where the seat belt goes thru the top of the seat there is a slot and depending on how you have your seat adjusted the belt can slip out of its location. These clips snap on and stop this problem.

 Next was a shelf that goes in the storage area behind the radio screen, they also offer a bin guard that keeps small items from going into the slot for the screen when it's open. These items can be found at Sandyeggo Designs <u>https://</u> www.sandyeggodesigns.com/products/




