JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about having your corvette towed. I have heard some horror stories about damage to the front end from inexperienced tow truck drivers. And cars that are way too low, which is where I think I fit in. There are some things you can do to make this a bit easier. The first thing might be expressing to the tow company just how low your car is and that it is a corvette and please send someone experienced. If you own a C8 or C7 you can carry a screw in tow ring that can be installed behind a small access door on your bumper. Which could allow the car to be towed on to a flat bed without running chains or straps under the front end. These screw in tow rings can be purchased for as low as \$35-\$70 on Amazon and you can just keep it in the car and hope you will never need it. If you own a C5 or C6 you would have to mount a bracket to the front frame which involves removing the front bumper cover, which is what I'm considering doing to my car. If your car is at a factory height and you don't have a front spoiler to worry about your car might be able to be pulled on the traditional way.

While investigating this subject, I learned something about towing the C8 which only comes with an automatic transmission. And that is if you don't have power and can't shift the car into neutral the car has to be put on special roller wheels because it CAN NOT BE DRAGGED ONTO THE FLATBED if the transmission is damaged from doing this GM will not cover it. Another alternative is to remove the inside panel in the trunk to access the transmission and with the correct tool you can force the transmission into neutral the first tool I found is a wrench that puts it in neutral only when you are holding the wrench down and as soon as you let pressure off it is back in gear. There is also a tool you can mount to the transmission that allows you to put it in neutral then put a pin in the mounted plate to keep it in neutral as long as the pin is in that position.

I have not been able to find much info about putting the C7 in neutral with a no power situation except a couple of videos that remove the side panel then lift the console up so you can force the solenoid in so you can move the shifter. I'll add a couple of links to these subjects so you can check them out. And please if anyone reading this knows of some info on this subject let me know I will be happy to add an update in a future tip story.

Let's hope we never have to have our cars towed but if you do here are a few ideas that might help.

I'm sure you must have some tips you can share.
