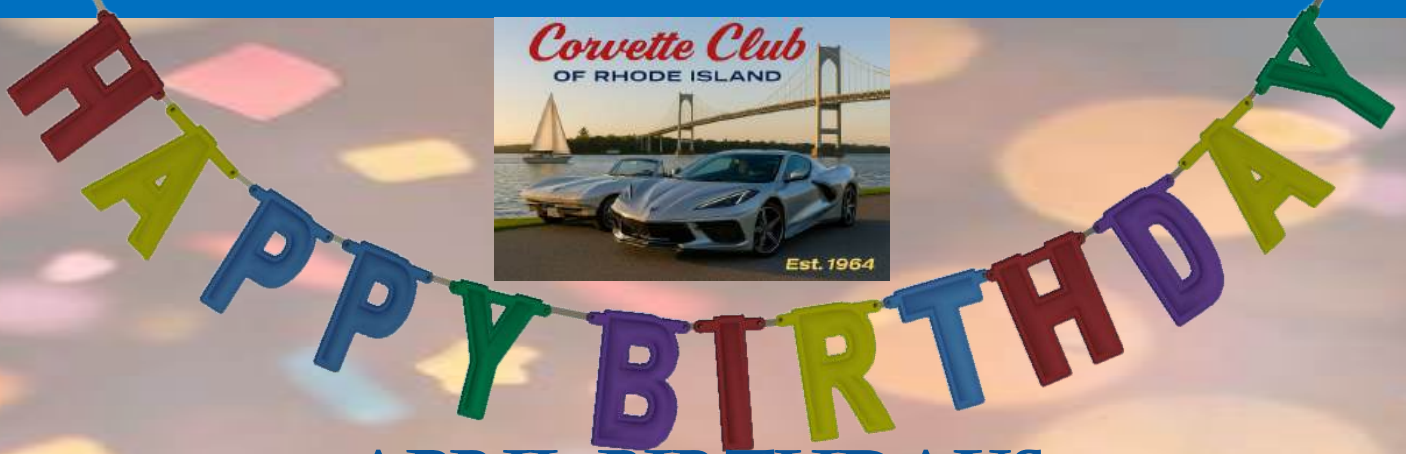

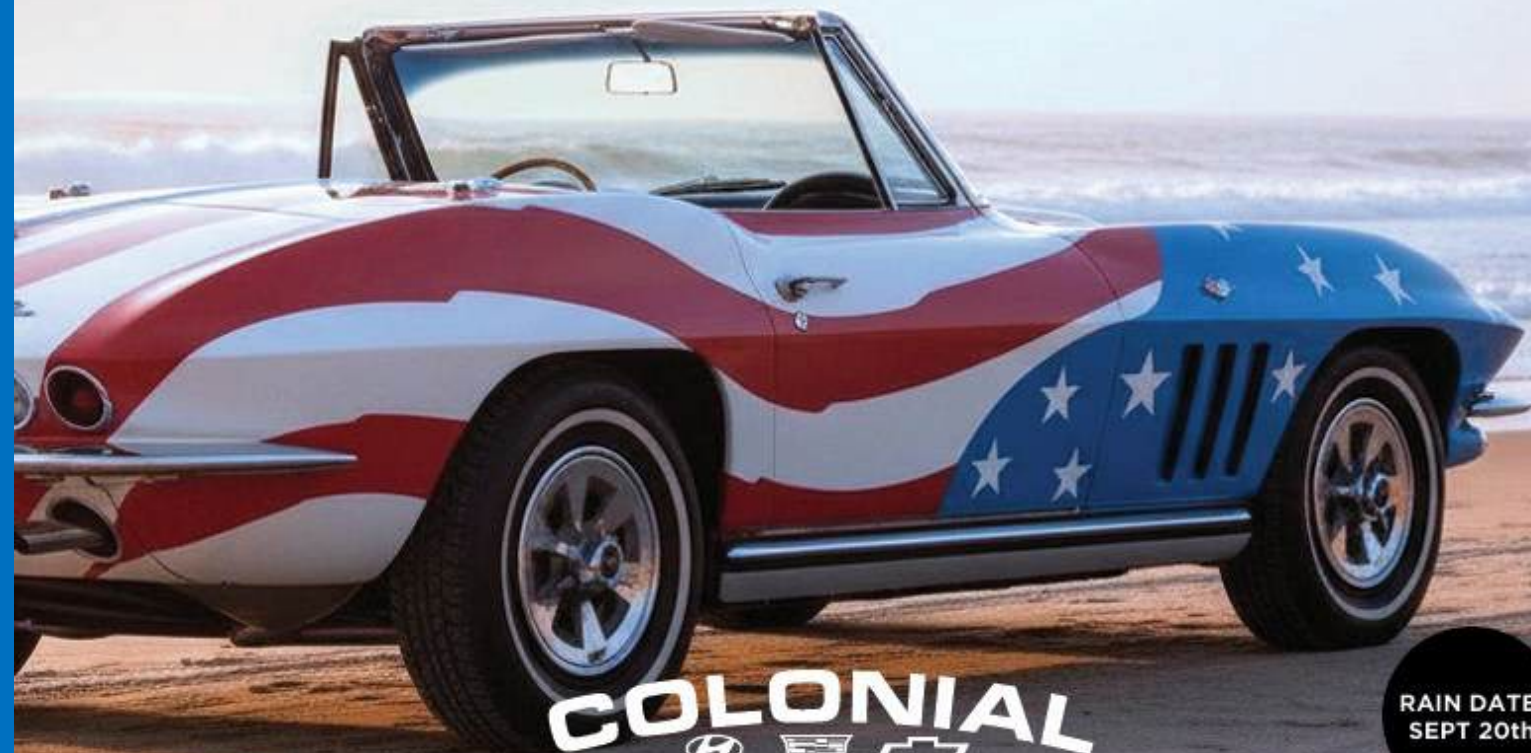

This month, I'd like to talk about electrical gremlins. I can't cover every issue, but here are a few I've noticed.

Common C5 Corvette electrical gremlins often stem from poor chassis grounds, low battery voltage, or corrosion in the serial bus communication lines. Main signs include erratic gauges, "Service Active Handling/ABS" warnings, and random dead batteries. The main fix is cleaning all 13 ground points.

Common C5 Corvette Electrical Gremlins:

Bad Grounds: The top cause of electrical problems, especially the 13 chassis ground points (notably G105 and G106 near the engine) that corrode or get loose.

Battery/Voltage Issues: The C5 is very sensitive to low voltage, which can cause false codes and strange behavior.

Door Accordion Wires: Broken wires inside the rubber boot between the door and body lead to window, lock, and mirror issues.

Ignition Switch Corrosion: Causes trouble starting, fuel pump failures, and instrument cluster problems.

HVAC and Instrument Panel Problems: The HVAC control head can drain the battery, and the DIC (Driver Information Center) might show random warnings due to a weak battery.

Passkey System Failures: The key resistor reader may fail to read the chip properly, preventing the car from starting.

Another thing I have heard is that because the battery sits above the computer, there have been many cases of leaking lead-acid batteries dripping down, causing corrosion of your frame and computer damage.

Common C6 Corvette electrical gremlins are mostly the same as those on C5 Corvettes. I have an additional one on my car caused by a loose wiring connection. GM Genuine Part 19179794 Steering Angle Sensor Lead Clip is used for steering angle sensor (SWPS) connector issues in 2005–2013 Corvettes and similar GM vehicles. It's a Terminal Positive Assurance (TPA) clip designed to prevent terminal movement and "Service Active Handling" messages caused by telescopic steering column movement.

Key Details:

Purpose: Secures the SWPS connector on the lower steering column to prevent terminal fret/high resistance.

Applicability: Known fix for C6 Corvette "Service Active Handling" issues.

Action: Often installed to fix the "Service Active Handling" message, especially when turning the steering wheel or during specific handling conditions.

If your C6 Corvette shows random traction control or active handling warnings, this clip is a simple, low-cost fix.

JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

Known C7 Corvette electrical gremlins mainly come from low battery voltage, which causes erratic dashboard errors, phantom codes, and no-start issues. Major causes include weak or failing batteries, loose negative terminals, corroded grounds, and delicate wiring harnesses. Using a trickle charger and checking connections usually solves these problems.

Common Electrical Gremlins:

Battery Issues: The C7 is very sensitive to low voltage, leading to various malfunctions. A weak battery can cause infotainment screens to lag or show errors.

Loose/Broken Negative Terminal: The ground cable clamp may not fit tightly on the battery post, causing sudden power loss while driving.

Broken Small Wire at Battery: A tiny wire attached to the battery can easily break, leading to a no-start situation.

Ground Connections: Corrosion or loose connections on the main chassis grounds can cause random electrical failures.

Parasitic Drain: If key fobs are kept too close to the car, they can drain the battery by keeping the car's computer active.

Infotainment/Screen Problems: Black screens or flickering displays are often due to faulty ECU connectors or loose wiring in the HMI module.

Starter Wiring: Heat-related issues in the starter wiring can cause hot-start problems.

Known issues in C8 Corvettes often relate to battery management, software glitches, and communication failures. Common signs include rapid battery drain, "frunk" open warnings, erratic infotainment behavior, and false error codes (like service front lift). A specific 2021 recall addresses a software bug that causes airbag warning lights.

Top Electrical Problems & Common Gremlins:

Battery Drain: The C8 is sensitive to battery voltage, which can cause rapid drain if not driven often or due to failed over-the-air updates.

Frunk/Door Confusion: False alerts about the front trunk (frunk) being open, even when latched, may trigger alarms or prevent starting.

Software/Infotainment Problems: Frozen screens, unresponsive touchscreens, and rearview camera issues.

Transmission/Engine Codes: Random error lights, "Service Front Lift" alerts, or the car going into "limp mode" are often due to sensor problems.

Self-Actuating Components: Reports of horn beeping unexpectedly, power windows cycling on their own, and spurious alerts.

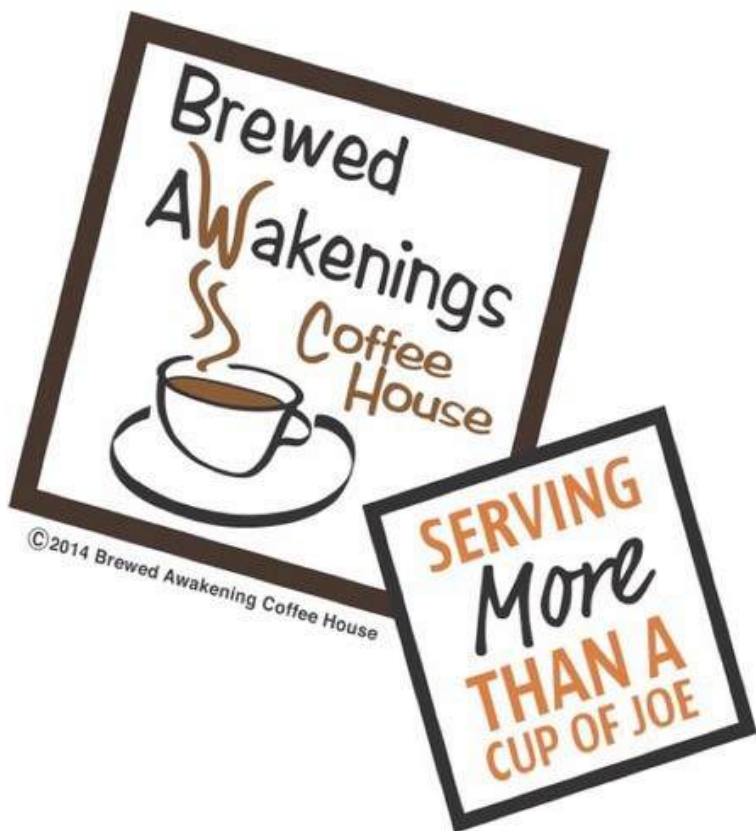

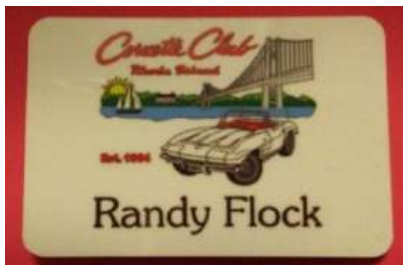

This CCRI hat was signed by Larry Shinoda and Zora Duntov at the 1993 Corvettes of Carlisle Weekend. Zora Duntov passed away in April 1996 and Larry Shinoda a little over a year later November 13, 1997. They both had significant influences on Corvette.



Larry Shinoda - March 25, 1930 – November 13, 1997 – American Automotive Designer
Shinoda was assigned a six month orientation class after being hired by GM, but was pulled early and assigned to the Chevrolet studio after one of his designs attracted attention: there he was credited with designing sharper fins, including the manufacturing process, for the 1959 Impala.

According to Shinoda, he was recruited for GM design chief Bill Mitchell's "special styling projects" Studio X after beating Mitchell in an impromptu drag race from a stoplight in 1958.



For the rest of his twelve total years at GM, Shinoda primarily designed concept cars, including the Mako Shark show car and CERV I. Working with Mitchell and Corvette chief engineer Zora Arkus-Duntov, he refined the XP 819 and other concept cars that eventually translated into the original 1963 Corvette Sting Ray design. Shinoda also led design work on the revised 1968 version that borrowed heavily from his Mako Shark concept. *Wikipedia*
