

This month I want to talk about the C8 DCT Service.

I don't own a C8 but will do my best to discuss the necessary service to meet the GM Warranty.

Regular service for C8 Corvette DCT (Dual Clutch Transmission) transmissions includes:

- External Canister Filter Replacement:
- Initially at 7,500 miles. It's crucial to perform this service within the 7,000 to 8,000-mile range to maintain the warranty. If the filter was changed early (before 7,000 miles), it still needs to be replaced again between 7,000 and 8,000 miles.
- Subsequently, at 22,500 miles and every 22,500 miles thereafter.

[According to MidEngineCorvetteForum.com](https://www.midenginecorvetteforum.com), the filter doesn't need to be changed earlier than 7,500 miles, and GM will cover only one filter change.

- Starting with 2023 models, the C8 features a maintenance minder that will notify the driver when the 7,500-mile service is approaching and every 22,500 miles after that.

- DCT Fluid Change:

- Every three years or 45,000 miles, whichever comes first. Even if the car has fewer than 7,500 miles, the fluid still needs to be changed at the 3-year mark.

The fluid has a three-year shelf life, according to [YouTube](#), and the fluid life system must be reset after a fluid change.

- The fluid required is a specific AC Delco DCT fluid, and approximately 11 to 12 quarts are needed for a full fluid change.

- Internal Filter:

There is also an internal filter, but it's only changed if there's a catastrophic transmission failure, according to [YouTube](#). It is not considered a regularly serviceable item.

- Flush Procedure:

[According to YouTube](#), the MDI flush procedure is mandatory after the fluid change and only after the new filter is installed. This procedure involves using a scan tool to run the transmission fluid through the filter at a higher pressure to dislodge particles before the new filter is installed. The flush takes about 8 minutes and is performed at around 2,000 RPMs.

## Important Notes:

- GM emphasizes following the maintenance schedule strictly to maintain the warranty.
- Some sources suggest that if the filter is changed before 7,500 miles, it might need to be replaced again at 7,500 miles to uphold the warranty.
- 2024 and later models have separated the complimentary oil change and transmission filter change into distinct warranty items.
- If the transmission needs to be replaced, the filter replacement schedule should be followed based on the mileage from the replacement.

To elaborate on the MDI flush procedure and the tools needed

The MDI flush procedure for the C8 Corvette's Dual Clutch Transmission (DCT) is a critical step in the transmission filter and fluid service. It helps ensure the transmission functions properly and maintains its longevity.

Here's a breakdown of the MDI flush procedure and the tools needed:

## MDI flush procedure details

- **Purpose:** The MDI flush procedure runs the DCT fluid through the new external canister filter at an elevated pressure to dislodge and capture any remaining contaminants that might be in the system, preventing them from recirculating into the transmission after the new filter is installed.
- **Timing:** The flush is performed after the new external canister filter is installed, and after a DCT fluid change.
- **Process:** A scan tool is used to command the transmission control module to execute the flush routine. The car's engine runs at around 2,000 RPMs for about 8 minutes while the scan tool actuates the solenoids and pressures inside the transmission, forcing the fluid through the external canister filter.
- **Conditions for flush:**
  - Transmission fluid must be at 140°F.
  - Brake pedal applied.
  - Engine running.
  - Transmission in Park or Neutral.
  - Vehicle speed at 0 mph.
- **Effect on fluid:** The MDI flush procedure does not exchange any of the transmission fluid; it only circulates the existing fluid to remove contaminants and directs them into the filter.

# JUST THE TIPS **S** WITH RICK LYONS

## Tools needed

- **GM MDI 2 Diagnostic Tool:** This is the essential tool for performing the MDI flush, as it allows the technician to communicate with the car's computer system and command the flush routine.
- **Scan Tool:** In addition to the GM MDI 2, a compatible scan tool is needed to access the transmission control module and initiate the flush procedure.
- **ACDelco DCT Fluid:** 11 to 12 quarts of the specific ACDelco DCTF FFL-4 fluid are required for a full fluid change.
- **External Canister Filter:** The new external filter needs to be installed before the flush procedure is performed.

## Important considerations

- **Dealer Service:** The C8's advanced DCT requires specialized knowledge and tools to properly service it, including the MDI flush procedure.
- **Warranty:** Following the recommended maintenance schedule, including the filter and fluid changes and the MDI flush, is crucial to maintain the warranty on the transmission.
- **DIY Service:** While some aspects of the DCT service can be performed by experienced DIYers, the MDI flush requires a specific scan tool and software typically available at dealerships or specialized shops.

I would recommend you watch the attached video links to better understand the DCT service.

I would also say consider that it takes around 13 qts of fluid at \$40-\$45 per qt and the cost of the filter and time involved when you get that hefty bill from the dealer.
