JUST THE TIPS

WITH RICK LYONS

This month, I'd like to talk about the C8 Corvette Grand Sport, which looks like it will be the last model change offered before the next-generation C9 comes out. The Grand Sport serves as the ultimate "sweet spot" for the C8 generation, combining the aggressive track-ready widebody of the Z06 with a more manageable, daily-drivable power output. It features a massive new naturally aspirated engine, revives classic heritage liveries, and introduces a high-performance hybrid variant.

Key New Features & Upgrades

The New LS6 Engine: Both the standard Grand Sport and base Stingray now pack a brand-new 6.7-liter naturally aspirated pushrod V-8, replacing the older 6.2-liter. It pumps out 535 horsepower and 520 lb-ft of torque—giving it the most torque ever offered in a naturally aspirated production V-8.

The Grand Sport X: Replacing the E-Ray, this hybrid all-wheel-drive version pairs the 6.7L V-8 with a front electric motor for a massive combined output of 721 horsepower. It features an electric-only "Stealth Mode" and comes standard with carbon-ceramic brakes.

Z06 Styling & Handling: The Grand Sport wears the Z06 widebody (about 3.5 inches wider than the standard Stingray) and includes the same Magnetic Ride Control and Z06-derived aerodynamics.

Heritage Design: Chevy is reviving the famous Admiral Blue Metallic launch color, alongside optional red, white, or blue hash marks and heritage stripes honoring the C4 generation.

Z52 Performance Packages: Replacing the old Z51

LS6 motors are coming with lithium-ion batteries, and they are using 5W-50 Supercar Mobil 1 oil. They also come with air deflectors that push air into the engine compartment.

The Z52 Packages

Z52 Sport Performance Package: Adds stiffer suspension, Michelin Pilot Sport 4S summer tires, and the high-performance J56 iron brakes from the C8 Z06.

Z52 Track Performance Package: Features J57 carbon-ceramic brakes, sticky Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2R tires, track-tuned suspension, and aggressive carbon-fiber aero elements (front splitter, dive planes, rockers, and high wing

The Z52 Track Package also comes with the center quad exhaust, which can be ordered as a stand-alone option on Grand Sport models.

Trim & Pricing Breakdown

The Grand Sport is available in 1LT, 2LT, and 3LT coupe and convertible trims

Grand Sport: Starts from roughly \$88,495 for the 1LT, scaling up to ~\$99,245 for the 3LT.

Grand Sport X: Starts from \$112,195 for the 1LT and goes up to \$123,145 for the 3LT.

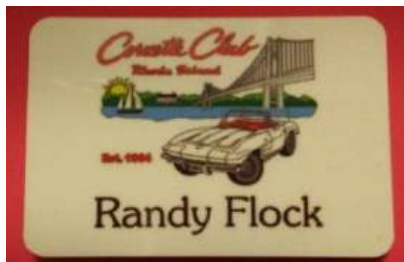

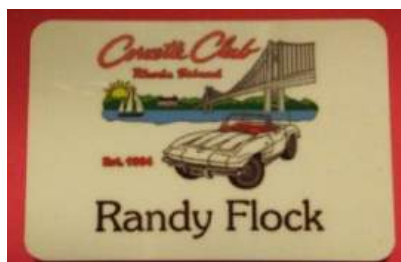

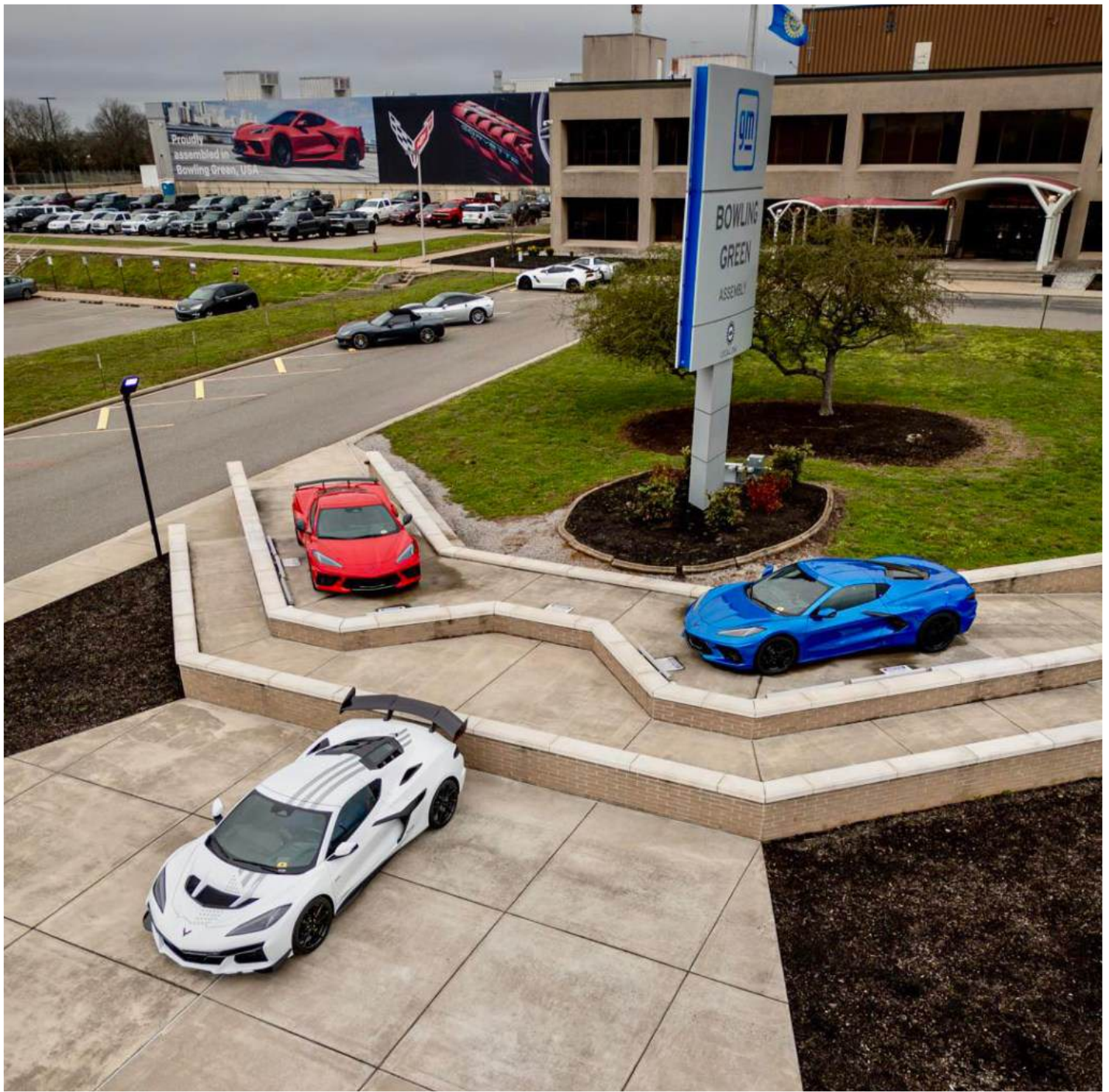
