Just The Tip

Just The Tip With Rick Lyons

This month I want to talk about convertible top care. I decided to use a well known product called RaggTopp. On a lot of instructional sites, it says to spray the top down with water, spray the cleaner product then brush in for a few minutes. Rinse it off the top and if needed repeat the process. Let it dry completely before spraying the protectant on. They recommend one coat sprayed in one direction and second coat in the other direction and let it sit until dry.

The way I did mine was to vacuum the top to get any pollen and dust out of the fibers before hosing it because I thought the hose pressure might just drive the dirt in. Then I sprayed it down with the hose then after it was well soaked, I sprayed the cleaner on very heavy and brushed the top with the horse hair brush supplied with the kit. After letting it soak for several minutes I rinsed it well and to my surprise a lot more dirt came out than I expected. So I repeated the process. Then I decided to vacuum the top to get as much water as possible off the top to speed up the process of drying. After it sat in the sun and completely dried, I sprayed the whole can of protectant on the top concentrating on the seams. Then I put a pair of latex gloves on and I massaged the chemical into the fibers. Working the area of the seams thoroughly until I could see that it was all worked in. After it dried I was very happy with the results.




