

# JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about C6 Headlight lenses, they are known for deteriorating quickly. The options are replacing them or trying to polish them. Most need to be replaced with aftermarket lights or in my case, I replaced the lenses on my original headlights. You can buy just the lenses at several places on-line. It is a process that most handy people can handle, the toughest part is probably removing the headlight assembly from the car. Once you have the lights out you need to remove the rubber gasket and little grommets then place them in the oven at 225 degrees for 15 minutes to soften up the adhesive so you can pry the two halves apart. Most people use a couple of large screwdrivers and work their way around the perimeter. In my case, it did not want to separate so I had to use my vibrating saw and cut the lens off then place it back in the oven and grab the remaining edge with vise grips and pull it out, it was a bit of a chore but manageable. Once I removed the rest of the lens material, I still had to get the rubber butyl adhesive out. To do that I used needle nose vise grips and locked on some of it I pried up and kept twisting it as it stretched it let go of the housing. After getting that done I had to transfer the painted portion from the old lens to the new one. After cleaning everything I placed the new Butyl into the channel stretching it as I went along to make sure it fit correctly. Then I was able to place the new lens onto the other half of the light making sure to line it up carefully. Next, I put it back in the oven for 15 mins to soften the butyl and I pressed the two halves together and put 6 spring clamps evenly spaced around the edge to apply even pressure while the adhesive cooled. I am pretty happy with the way they turned out and the parts cost me around \$100.00 and it gave me something to write about.

#### Better Safe than Sorry - Stop Corvettes from Being Stolen



Many of you heard after the New England Caravan attended the NCM's 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration in Bowling Green, KY some folks took a post caravan trip to Memphis. There two of our NE group Corvettes were stolen. The C7 convertible (above) was found just a few days later stripped in a yard and the red C7 Z06 Coupe (below) was never recovered. It was stolen in broad daylight in front of their hotel room. They heard the alarm go off. They banged on the window to stop the thieve...he aimed a pistol at them, they hit the floor and a few seconds later the car was gone. I encourage you to watch the two youtube links (first one shows actual theft video) and second ones goes over what you can do to keep you Corvette from being stolen.
