JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about bleeding your brakes. I know for most people it seems unnecessary, your brakes are working fine. But when you really need them in an emergency is when they're likely to fail. Also I'm not the first owner of my car and I don't know when the last time it was done, if ever. Brake fluid absorbs moisture which can build up in the system to the point of causing corrosion and boiling of the fluid causing brake fade in extreme braking conditions. Each model year has a recommended brake fluid type usually found on the master cylinder cap. When bleeding the system there are many ways to drain the fluid such as gravity bleeding, pumping the pedal bleeding and pressure bleeding. I am planning to change my fluid in the spring and I'm going to use a vacuum system that hooks to shop air and sucks the old fluid from each wheel cylinder / caliper and has a reservoir with fresh fluid that attaches to the master cylinder so you won't run out of fluid while removing the old. It is a pretty easy procedure to open and drain each wheel cylinder / caliper starting with the farthest one from the master cylinder and working your way around. I want to go one step farther on my car I bought a scan tool that has the capability to activate the ABS system and will pump the fluid that is in the ABS. In most cases it probably isn't necessary but a good idea if you have the ability. I hope to do an update on this after I change my brake fluid this coming spring.

I have the FOUR UNCLES 2L Vacuum Brake Bleeder and FOXWELL NT630 Pro 12V OBD2 Scanner Battery Tester, ABS Scanner.

I would say whether you do it yourself or have it done it is a worth while maintenance procedure.

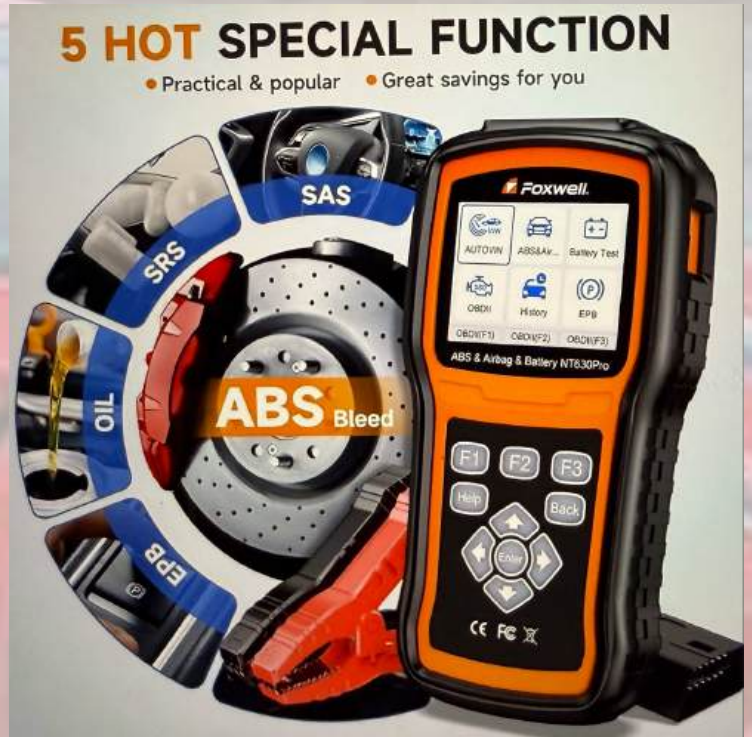

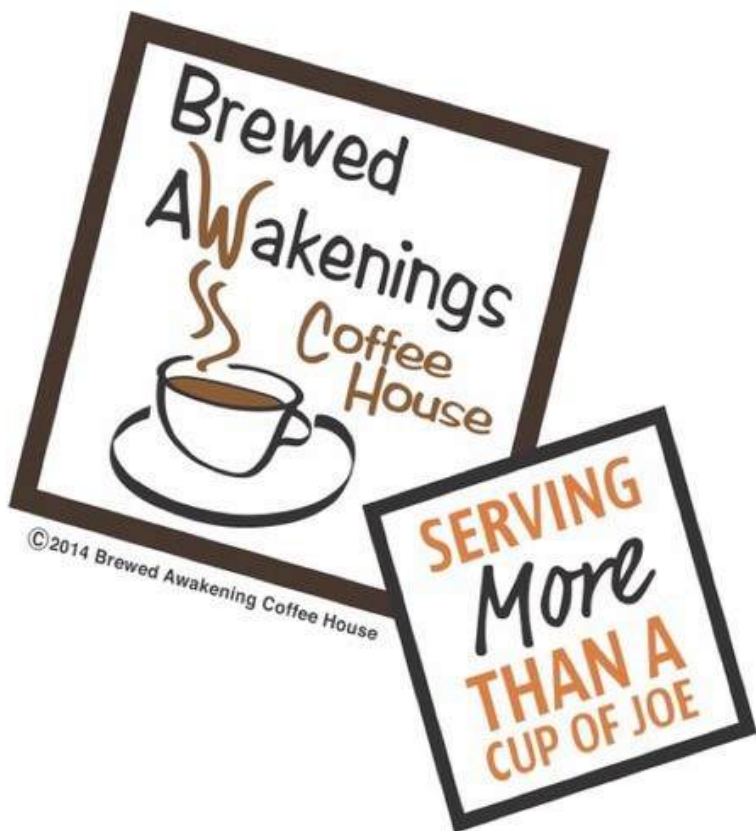

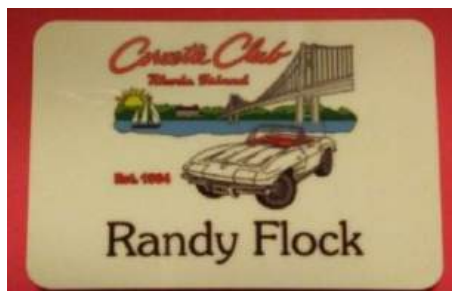

Better Safe than Sorry – Stop Corvettes from Being Stolen



Many of you heard after the New England Caravan attended the NCM's 30th Anniversary Celebration in Bowling Green, KY some folks took a post caravan trip to Memphis. There two of our NE group Corvettes were stolen. The C7 convertible (above) was found just a few days later stripped in a yard and the red C7 Z06 Coupe (below) was never recovered. It was stolen in broad daylight in front of their hotel room. They heard the alarm go off. They banged on the window to stop the thief...he aimed a pistol at them, they hit the floor and a few seconds later the car was gone. I encourage you to watch the two youtube links (first one shows actual theft video) and second ones goes over what you can do to keep you Corvette from being stolen. It's up to you to take action to protect your car. I recommend the two claw club and it's only around \$40.00. If your Corvette is parked next to a Corvette without a club ... which car will they attempt to steal ?...slow them down or even better yet... discourage them.
