



JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

This month, I'd like to discuss the Grand Sport vs the Base Model.

The main difference is that the Grand Sport (GS) is a track-focused version of the base Corvette, featuring a wide-body, Z06-level brakes and cooling, wider tires (Michelin Super Sports) and often a dry-sump oil system (manuals), while the base model offers a great driving experience for the street, with the Z51 package providing similar performance upgrades but not the wide body. Essentially, the GS blends the base's street-friendly power with Z06 handling hardware, making it ideal for spirited driving or track days, whereas the base is more for cruising.

Base Model Corvette (e.g., C6/C7)

- Focus: Comfortable street driving, enjoyable performance.
- Engine: Same powerful V8 (LS3 for C6, LT1 for C7) as the GS, often 430-460 hp.
- Handling: Good, but less aggressive than the GS.

Grand Sport (GS) Corvette

- Wide Body: Takes styling and hardware from the Z06, including wider fenders.
- Brakes: Z06-level Brembo brakes for superior stopping power.
- Cooling: Enhanced cooling for the engine, transmission, and brakes (ducts and coolers).
- Tires: Wider Michelin Pilot Super Sport (or better) tires for more grip.
- Suspension: More aggressive setup for better cornering.
- Engine (Manuals): Often includes Z06's dry-sump oiling system for sustained performance.
- Best For: Enthusiasts who want track capability without the extreme nature (or cost/issues) of a Z06.

Key Takeaway

- Base: Great all-around sports car, excellent for daily driving and spirited road use.
- Grand Sport: A "best of both worlds" option, combining base power with Z06-level handling hardware, making it a more capable track car that still looks and feels special.


The Mission Continues - The Momentum Builds
