# The 1963 Corvette Grand Sport



Despite GM's participation in the AMA sanctioned racing ban, Zora Arkus-Duntov secretly built the Grand Sport Corvette as a means of competing with Ford, Ferrari (and other manufacturers) on the world racing stage. Duntov built these cars in secret, and when it was discovered they were being put together, the program was shut down and Duntov outwardly reprimanded for the decision. However, before that happened, Duntov had been successful in building five examples of the incredible GS racer. More importantly, the car was a powerhouse, and it wasn't long before GM was looking at the Grand Sport as a way to bolster the performance of other race-developed vehicles. All five of these cars still exist today, and each is a highly valuable, highly coveted collectable, demanding millions of dollars each time one changes hands.
