

JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

Just The Tip

This month I want to talk about keeping service records. One of the best ways to keep your service records is by putting them on a USB thumb drive so you can have a copy on your computer and the drive. You can add photos of your car, especially after detailing it for a show, that way you will have the best pictures for future use like when it's time to sell. Don't forget to take photos of all the receipts for parts you installed as well as parts installed by your mechanic, don't forget things like when tires were replaced or when you added that small aftermarket piece. Then I would recommend you store the drive in the glove box so it's always with the car.

The next thing I want to talk about is an update on a couple of things I wrote about in past newsletters. One of them is the Boot-Bag I purchased for our caravan trip. We did a trial run with it during our trip to Maine for Back 2 Beach. It worked great for us and it freed up half of my trunk space for other things. It was easy to install, it stayed in place, and never seemed to move even with Mario Connie Andretti driving. Also I was able to open the trunk while it was installed and was able to use the convertible top while installed.

The other product I want to update you on is the Soler Bluetooth Throttle Controller I installed. It was very easy to install just plug-n-play. After connecting to my phone I had complete control of the throttle via Bluetooth. It has plenty of setting to try from weather mode to drag race mode as well as valet, a theft mode which doesn't allow the peddle to work at all. So far I'm very happy with it and I'm still trying new settings.
