





JUST THE TIPS WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about anti-theft or at least slowing down thieves.

The first thing is, if you have a garage, make sure you use it. And maybe park your daily driver in front of the garage where your Corvette is. Next, make sure your car is locked when you walk away. You should also use a Faraday pouch for your key fob at all times when not in use. They block the signal from being copied.

You may remember the old school steering wheel club that locks on the steering wheel. They are making a comeback because it will slow down the thief, or maybe when he sees it he will choose another car before going through the extra work.

People are also using Apple AirTags hidden in weather-proof pods to track their cars.

There is a kill switch available from Mobilistics that has its own key fob that cuts off the ignition and that goes in your fuse box in place of the factory one.

There are OBD2 locking covers to keep thieves from using your OBD2 port to recode your car.

There are dash cams that can turn on and upload to the cloud every time the car is started or disturbed and can film inside the cabin.

Also, something I mentioned in the past and something I use and really like a lot is a Solar Throttle Controller that has a lockout option that disables the throttle so if they start the car they can push on the peddle all they want it doesn't respond at all. It also has some other settings that are a lot of fun which give instant throttle response. It has many variable settings from mild to wild as well as weather mode and valet mode. If you check out some videos on YouTube people claim it feels like a different car because the throttle response is so quick, it doesn't add any horsepower but makes it available right away.
