

JUST THE TIPS

WITH RICK LYONS

Just The Tip

With Rick Lyons

This month I want to talk about the C5 model, Again I don't have one but while researching I found a few things you may want to know about.

The number 1 most common C5 Corvette Engine Problem and what the solution to this problem is, and other things you should consider replacing when doing this job.

The number one problem is the Oil Pressure Sensor goes bad and either reads to high or could read to low which can put the engine in limp mode.

The fix is something most enthusiast can fix on their own. You have to unbolt the intake and disconnect some vacuum lines and use a special tool to release the fuel line. After unbolting the intake you can move it forward toward the radiator or take it out. You will find the oil pressure sensor in the intake valley at the rear just take it out and replace. If you want to go an extra step there is a relocation kit so you won't have to remove the intake in the future.

But while the intake is off it's time to clean any debris you find and you should replace the two knock sensors located in the same area. You will need new manifold gaskets which isn't a terrible thing they're pretty old. And you might as well clean the throttle body while you have it there. It looks like parts for this will be around \$100 without the relocation kit, not bad.

Some other things I came across are switching out your battery for an AGM battery they are much more durable and last longer, the main problem with the original type of battery is they can leak acid and your battery is sitting right on top of your computer and you don't ever want that to happen.

Also the C5 is prone to harmonic balancer issues which most people are aware of, I had to replace the one in my C6.

There is also a problem that comes up occasionally that can lock the steering column. There is a fix known as lock module LMC5 from Compliance Parts it's suppose to be an easy fix. Compliance Parts also sells a part known as the GAGS Skip Module that lets you bypass that 1st to 4th shift lockout.

One other thing I saw often was upgrading the headlights which people complained about brightness there are plenty of options for better bulbs. There is also a light upgrade called sleepy eye conversion sold by KnightDriveTV the people that have them swear by them for brightness and they love the look. You can check them out on YouTube. I guess that's plenty for now.






