

# JUST THE TIPS **S** WITH RICK LYONS

This month I want to talk about gasoline. I recently read a report about gasoline quality. In the report, they mention that gasoline quality may be more important than oil quality. One of their thoughts is that the oil you choose isn't the same when mixed with fuel near the piston rings. They feel the type of additives and friction modifiers plus detergent in the gasoline plays a big part in the wear and tear of your engine. One of the things they claim is most gasoline is the same when it comes out of the pipeline but there are changes made to it during refining, such as filtering, and certain additives and friction modifiers make the most difference to engine wear. So when you buy premium gasoline you not only get higher octane you're getting a premium additive package. These are considered Top Tier gasoline and there is a website that lists Top Tier stations such as Sunoco, Exxon, and Mobil. Also, these additive packages help keep injectors and valves cleaner. You can find Top Tier stations here [STATION FINDER](#). It is also recommended to add a bottle of Chevron Techron complete fuel system cleaner after every oil change because all Top Tier gasoline is not the same and one bottle every 3000 miles costs pennie's. I have added some links to check out below. You can also get a Top Tier station finder app.


