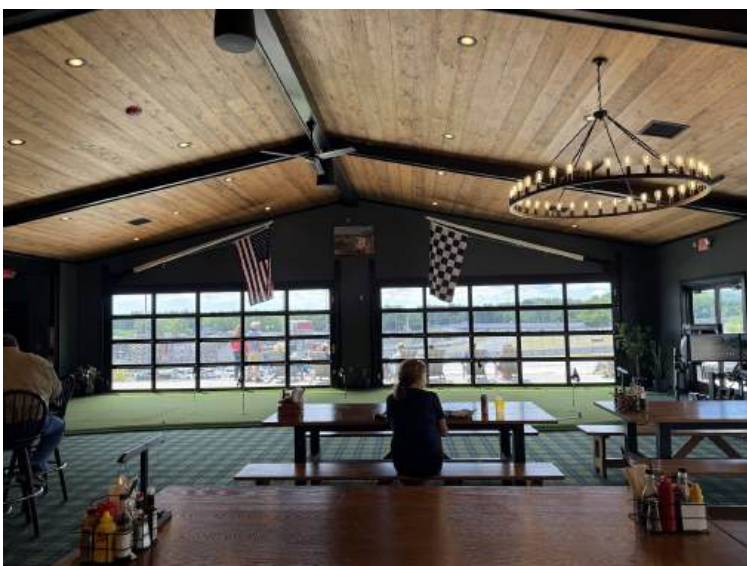

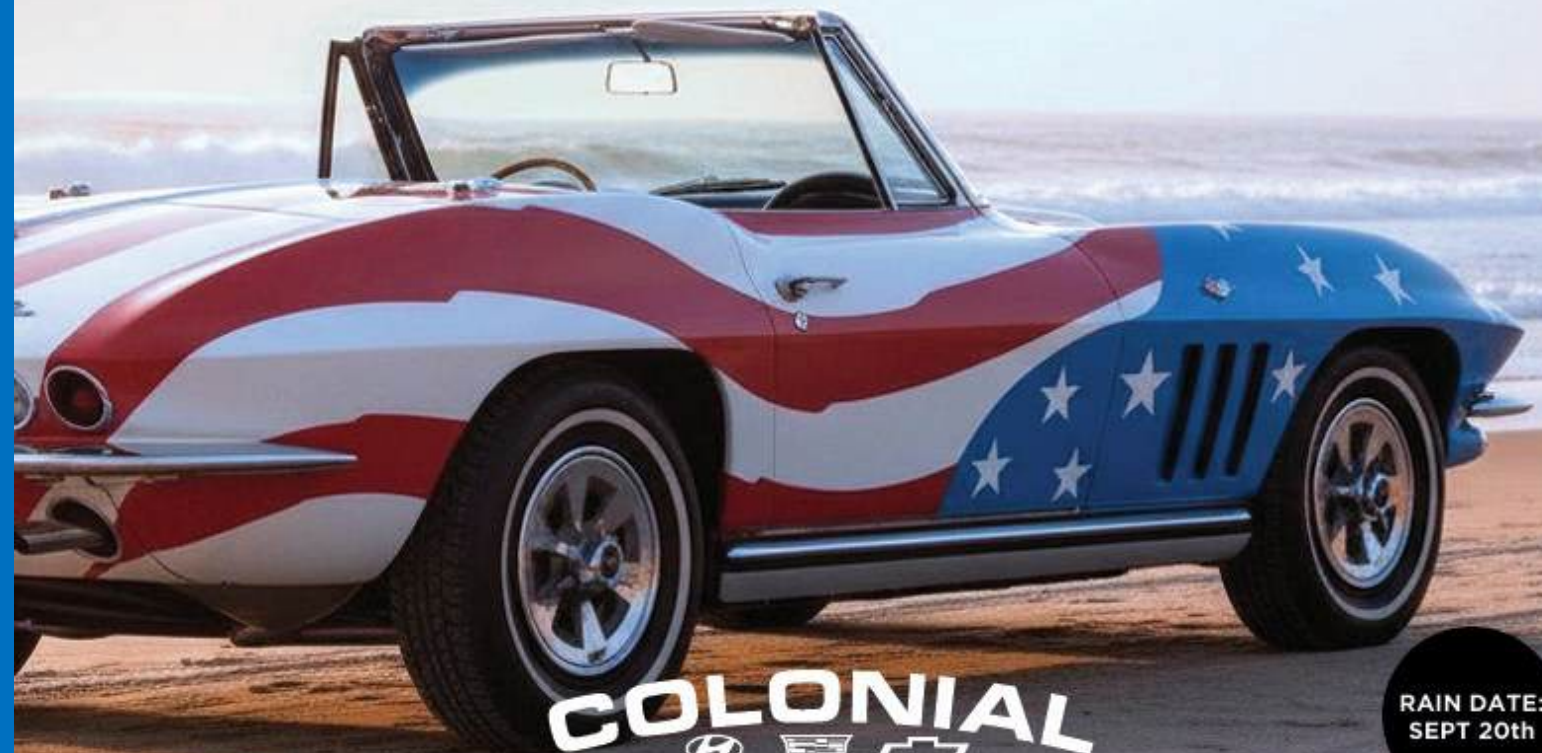

JUST THE TIPS

WITH RICK LYONS

This month, I'd like to talk about washing and caring for your Corvette with PPF and ceramic coating. I have covered this before, but with so many new cars in our club, it seemed like a good time to revisit.

The safest way to clean a C8 Corvette with Paint Protection Film (PPF) is to use a touchless pre-rinse followed by a two-bucket hand wash with pH-neutral soap. Avoid automated car washes and harsh chemicals, as they can cause micro-scratches or damage the PPF's edges.

1. Pre-Wash and Decontamination

Address the Bugs: The C8's front bumper easily collects bugs. Spray a dedicated PPF cleaner or bug remover on the front fascia and let it dwell for 30–60 seconds before washing.

Foam It Up: Use a pressure washer and foam cannon with a pH-neutral car soap. Let the thick foam dwell for a few minutes to lift heavy dirt and debris without rubbing them into the film.

Pre-Rinse: Rinse the car thoroughly from top to bottom, keeping the pressure washer wand at least 12-18 inches away from the film's edges to prevent lifting.

Here are some soaps that are good quality: Mr Pink Chemical Guys, Maguire Gold Class, Mothers Triple Action, Koch Chemie Active Foam, Adams Mega Foam, to name a few

2. The Contact Wash

Two-Bucket Method: Use one bucket for soapy water and one for rinsing your wash mitt. This keeps dirt out of your cleaning solution.

Straight-Line Motions: Gently wipe the car down using ultra-soft microfiber mitts or sponges in straight lines. Avoid circular scrubbing, which causes micro-marring and swirl marks.

Divide the Car: Wash the cleaner top panels first, and save the dirtier lower panels, engine vents, and the front bumper for last.

3. Engine Bay Vents & Glass

Watch the Vents: The rear hatch and side intake vents lead directly to the C8 engine bay. Lay microfiber towels inside the vents to catch excess water, and avoid spraying a direct, heavy stream of water into them.

Engine Cleaning: Instead of heavy hosing, wipe down the engine bay plastics with a damp microfiber cloth while the car is off and cool.

4. Drying Safely

Blow Dry: Use a dedicated car dryer or a leaf blower to force water out of crevices, emblems, and the rear window slit. This eliminates the need to physically drag a towel over the PPF. Be sure to avoid using a blower near the edges of the PPF.

Drying Aid: If using a microfiber towel, mist the towel or the panel with a quality detail spray or drying lubricant so the towel glides effortlessly over the PPF.

5. PPF Maintenance

Avoid Heat: Never use high-heat machine polishers on the PPF, and keep aggressive solvents like bug tar removers off the edges.

Ceramic Top-Coat: Apply a ceramic boost spray designed for PPF (like XPEL or Adam's products) every few months to maintain slickness and make future cleaning easier

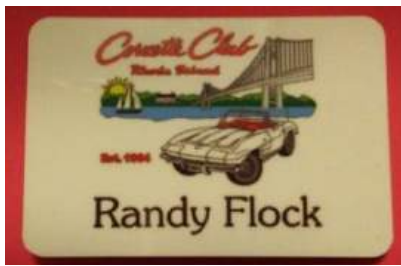

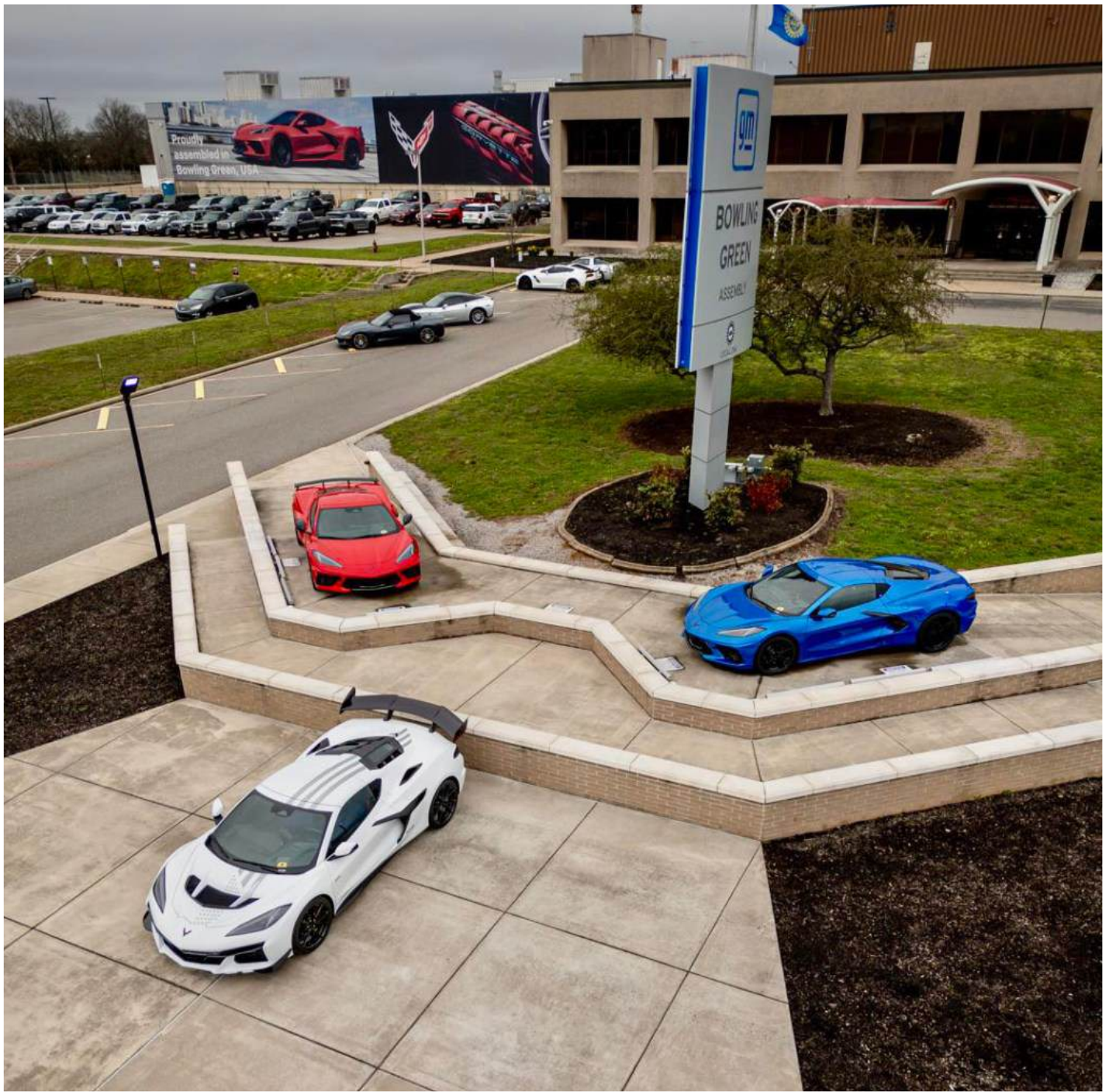

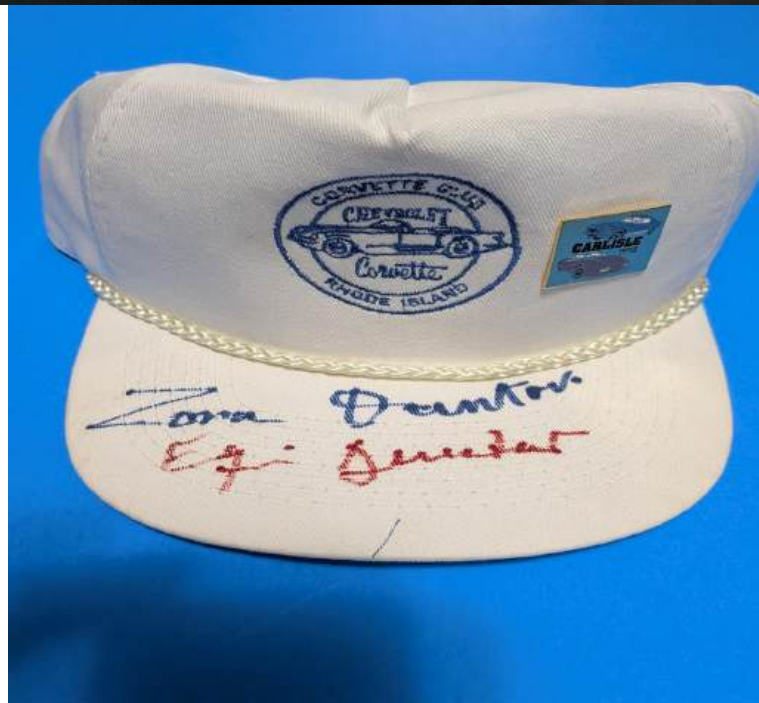
