

The 1963 Corvette Rondine



The 1963 Corvette Rondine.

Built by Italian coach builder Pininfarina on the chassis of a 1963 Corvette, the Corvette Rondine is part Ferrari, part Corvette, and all kinds of awesome! Commissioned by Chevrolet, the Corvette Rondine featured a number of identifiable Pininfarina design elements wrapped around the proportions of the factory Sting Ray. Although the car looks more Ferrari than Chevy, all of the car's underpinnings remained true to the second-generation Corvette, making this beauty a one-of-a-kind hybrid of Italian design and American muscle. This car actually lived in a museum from the time it was created until 2008, at which point it was purchased at auction by a private collector for a modest sum of just \$1.6 million dollars!
