



Just The Tip

With Rick Lyons This month I want to talk about fluid changes in my C6. I just changed the motor oil ,trans fluid and differential fluid. I used Mobil 1 extended performance 5W-30 with a Mobil 1 M1-113 Extended Performance Oil Filter it took just under 6 quarts

In the rear diff. I used ACDelco Dexron LS gear oil SAE 75W-90 GL-5 #88862624 which already has the additive needed for the limited slip it took just a bit over 2 guarts to fill.

In the trans I used Royal Purple SNYCHROMAX High Performance Manual Transmission Fluid that took just over 3 quarts

About my choices, I always use Mobil 1 oil and it is GM approved. The gear oil I chose was, after watching several YouTube videos and consulting a few Corvette Forums, and the consensus from all was to use the #88862624 because it already has the needed additive, if you use the Dexron 3 that's recommended, you need to add the limited slip fluid which was the way when my car was built but they have come up with better products since then. As far as the trans fluid it came down to the Corvette Forums. A lot of guys highly recommend the Royal Purple Synchromax claiming it worked great and was noticeably smoother shifting.

•••

If your thinking about doing your own it was very easy. No harder than a reg oil change. I do have to say using a lift really helps and you need to have the car level to do the trans & differential because you have to rely on the fill plugs to weep oil out to know you have the correct amount of fluid. And you will also need a bottle pump to transfer the oils from the container into trans & diff.

Seems very reasonable maybe the cost of an oil change at some places. My next project will be clutch fluid and brake fluid.

I'm trying to get ready for the Corvette Caravan this summer.

PS : there was one weird thing that came up a few times it was recommended to perform 8-12 figure 8's in a parking lot to get the new fluid into the clutches in diff.

I figured it wouldn't hurt anything so what the heck.

I'm sure you must have some tips you can share. If so e-mail me with your tips or technics.




