

# JUST THE TIPS S WITH RICK LYONS S

This month I want to talk about carrying a fire extinguisher in your car. Hopefully we never need it but it would be nice to have if we do or if one of your fellow enthusiast needs our help. There are many types of extinguishers and you should be careful choosing one. Some can be very corrosive to paint and electrical connections. There is another thing I didn't realize and that is most don't fight fires for very long usually about 10 sec, so you have to act quickly. But there are some very good ones out there that are designed to work on car fires. HalGuard Clean Agent Car Fire Extinguisher is a good one. But like most it has a shelf life and if you use it at all it has to be serviced. This service cost around \$50 the cost to buy one is about \$250. There is another one that I like it's the Element E100 Fire Extinguisher it's very different from a traditional Extinguisher . It's based on a chemical reaction and it lasts 90 seconds and cost about \$100 to purchase. It also is about the size of a road flare and has an extremely long shelf life. And isn't affected by cold or heat or moisture. Considering we don't have a lot of extra storage in our corvettes its size is a bonus. It also claims to be environmentally safe and the chemical is safe to breathe while using it.
