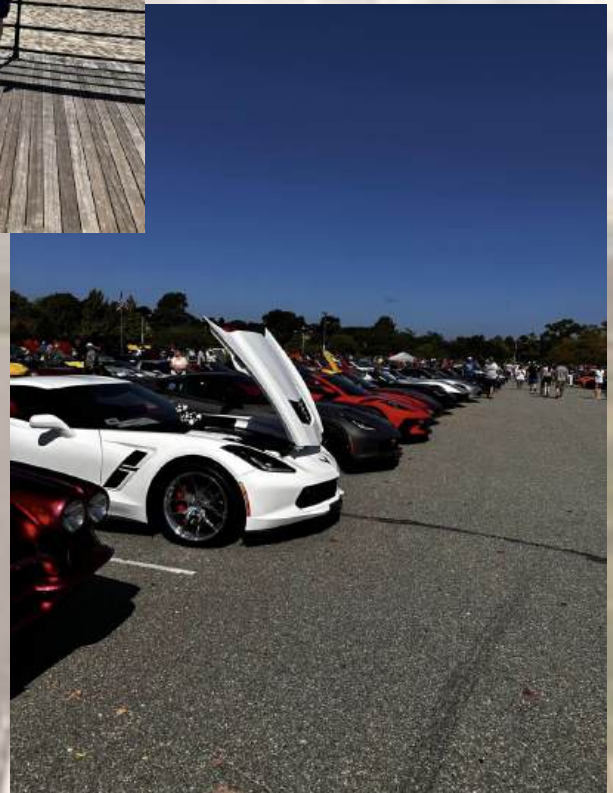

JUST THE TIPS **S** WITH RICK LYONS **S**

This month's tip is put together with help from Ernie Papineau.

I want to talk about communicating while traveling in your car. Most of us are familiar with standard Walkie talkies that we use while caravanning as a group but there are plenty of radios to choose from. The first ones I purchased were pretty nice they had Bluetooth connection for hands free operation but unfortunately I had a lot of difficulty making them work consistently and I returned them. Next I purchased an in expensive Motorola set that has worked out pretty well. They do have their short falls such as range and clarity. From what I'm told several members of our club have purchased new radios that are working very well. They are ROCKY TALKIE. They have given clear reception, over a mile apart, and you can get an optional hand mic/speaker that can be clipped to your seatbelt for convenient use . I believe they push 5 watts of power, which is at least twice the power of the average hand held. The batteries have been lasting 5 days and are rechargeable with a type C charger. It also can monitor 2 channels at the same time and has emergency weather reports and privacy channels.

In general, I have heard nothing but positive feedback from the 4 or more members that have them already. They do cost a bit more but sometimes you get what you pay for and this seems to be the case.

Some of us have also been using a new app called Zello Walkie Talkie from the App Store on your cell phone it has some positive features and I hope to write about it in the future when we've spent a bit more time with it.

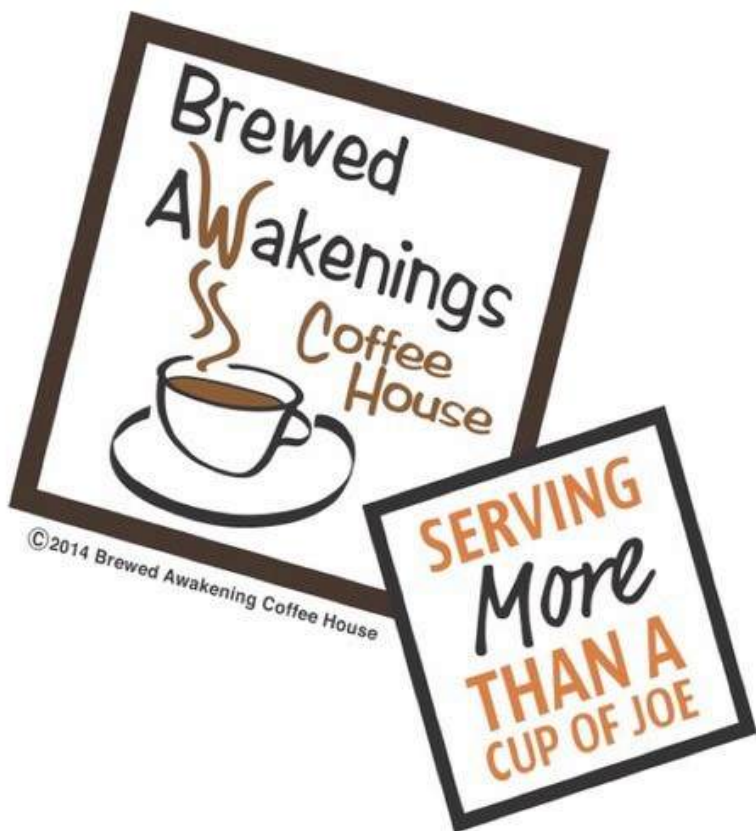
