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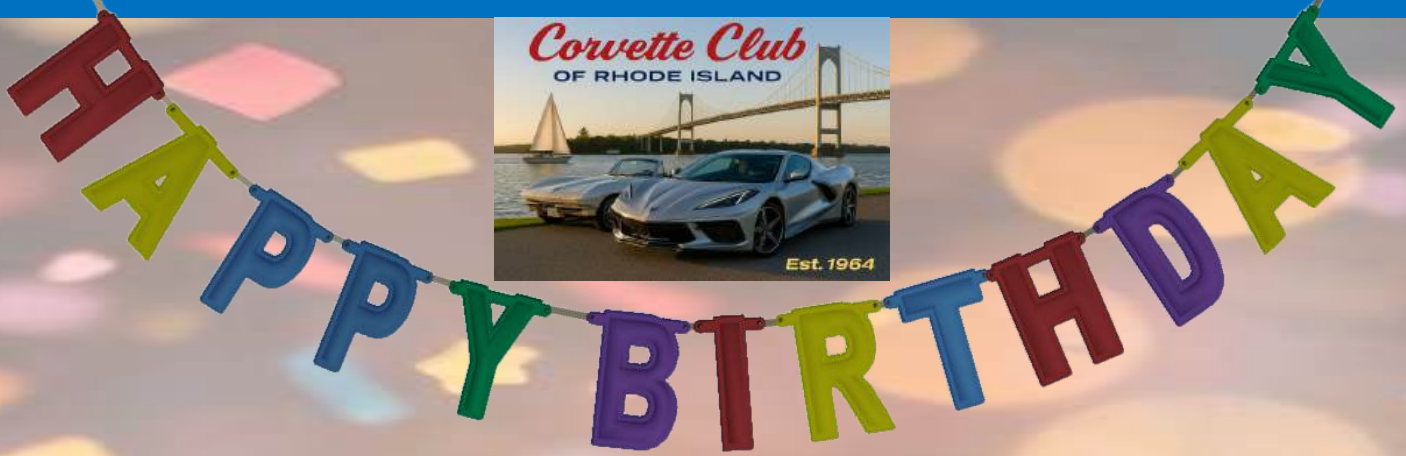

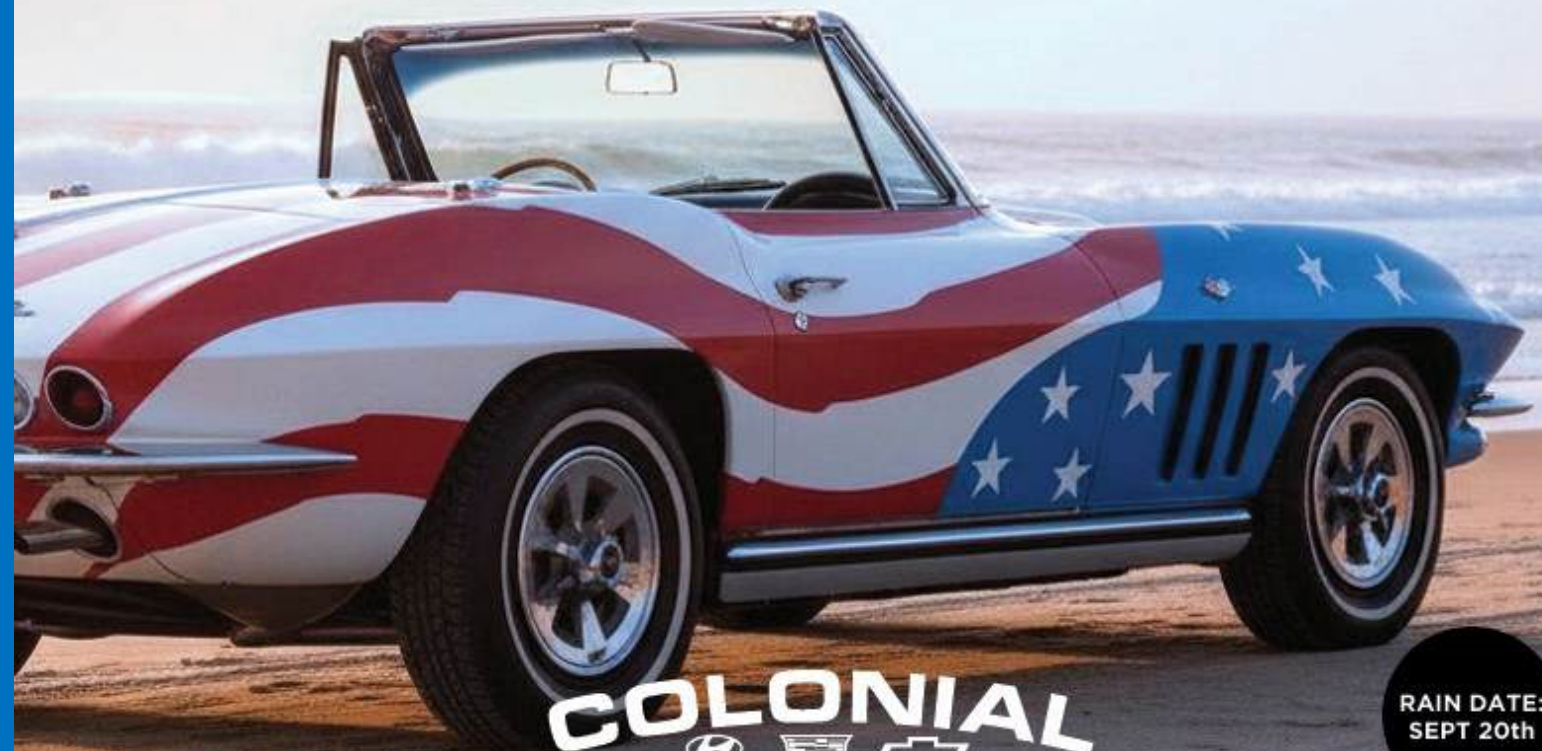

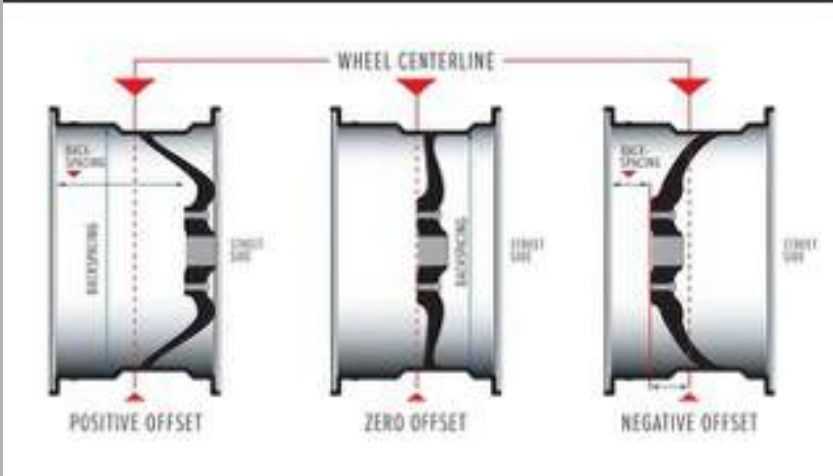

This month, I'd like to talk about wheel offsets.



Wheel offset is the distance from the mounting surface (where the wheel bolts to the car) to the exact middle line of the wheel, measured in millimeters.

What Offset Means

- **Zero Offset:** The mounting pad is right on the center line of the wheel.
- **Positive Offset:** The mounting pad is closer to the wheel's outer (front) face. This tucks the wheel further inside the car's fender.
- **Negative Offset:** The mounting pad is closer to the inside (back) of the wheel. This pushes the wheel outward to create a deep dish or wide

How to Determine Wheel Offset

Find the center line: Measure the total overall width of the wheel from edge to edge, then divide that number by two.

Measure the mounting distance: Place a straight edge across the back of the wheel and measure the distance from that straight edge to the hub mounting surface (in millimeters).

Calculate the offset: Subtract the center line measurement from your mounting surface measurement. If the result is positive, you have a positive offset; if it is negative, you have a negative offset.

Selecting the correct wheel offset for a Corvette depends on your specific generation (C5, C6, C7, or C8) and whether your car has a base or widebody/Z-performance setup. Wheel offset is the distance in millimeters from the wheel's centerline to its hub mounting surface.

Understanding Offset Basics

- **Positive Offset:** The mounting surface is closer to the outer face of the wheel, which pulls the wheel inward toward the suspension. Corvettes typically use high positive offsets (e.g., +40 to +79).
- **Lower Positive Offset:** Pushes the wheel outward toward the fender for a more flush or aggressive stance. Going too low risks fender rubbing.
- **Higher Positive Offset:** Tucks the wheel deeper inside the wheel well, giving more clearance but a more sunken look.

Factory Offset Guidelines by Generation

- **C5 (1997–2004):** Front wheels (17x8.5") use around a **+56** offset, while rear wheels (18x9.5" or 19x10") range from **+57 to +64**.
- **C6 Base (2005–2013):** Uses high offsets like **+56** (front 18x8.5") and **+79** (rear 19x10").
- **C6 Z06 / Grand Sport / ZR1:** Uses wider setups with lower offsets, such as **+40** (front 18x9.5" or 19x10") and **+59** (rear 19x12" / 20x12").
- **C8 Stingray (2020–Present):** Factory specs vary, but aftermarket fitments usually run **+30 to +45** in the front and **+40 to +50** in the rear depending on desired flushness.

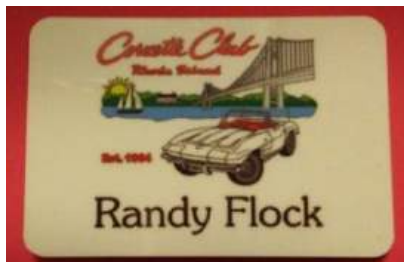

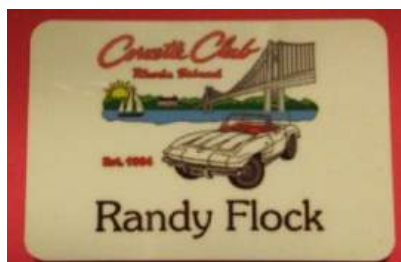
