

This month, I'd like to discuss winter car storage options. I recently purchased a car capsule storage system.



The one I bought is an indoor storage bubble. They offer a variety of capsule types, including outdoor units. The one I have is meant to be indoors, I think the main reason is UV protection. The way mine works is that you spread it out on the floor of your garage, then unzip the clear PVC top half from the black base that you park the car on. After unzipping you have to fold the top back to the opposite end. Then you can move the vehicle onto the base, making sure you place the car so it is equally spaced on all sides of the vehicle. Next, you can carefully unfold the top onto the vehicle all the way to the other end. At this point, I would put the fan into position which will inflate the capsule. And if you are going to use a battery tender this is a good time to hook that up. Next, you will need to zip the top to the bottom all the way around. At this point you can plug in the fan and start inflating you may have to hold the fan unit up so it's easier to get air circulating. It takes about 10 minutes to fully inflate. It might take a few days for the wrinkles to work away, if the wrinkles don't clear up to your satisfaction there are some tips on YouTube to get them out.

The unit I have seems to be meant for long-term storage since it wouldn't be easy to regularly put the car in and out often. They do have other units that stay inflated and allow you to unzip a door to bring the car in or out whenever you like. That convenience comes at a cost.

From my investigation, these capsules do a good job of keeping out all pests and dust, and dirt from your car. A couple of reviews recommend putting some Damp-Rid inside the unit to capture any moisture. I will be adding some Damp-Rid and my regular rodent repellent just to be on the safe side.

I have attached a few links to get you more familiar with this product. There are also other companies offering similar products.






